The intent of the Joan Wolfe Legacy Grant is to assist schools and community organizations that help children to achieve success in learning through the arts. For 2019 the maximum individual grant is \$1,000. The total for all grants is \$2,000. The application must be fully completed to be considered. Examples of the types of programs the Foundation is willing to consider include the following

- Art Materials
- Operational Assistance
- Community Centers
- Early Childhood Development

The funding for grants comes from the Foundations fundraising efforts. Applications are accepted and reviewed March 1- April 30. Grant recipients will be notified by phone &/or email by the 2<sup>nd</sup> Friday in May. All recipients will be invited to our annual awards banquet held the last week of June.

Applications received outside of this window will be asked to reapply the following year.
